BOND ISSUE DEBATE.

Senator Hill Protests Against the Peffer Resolution. SENATOR HOAR IN FAVOR OF IT. Populist Allen and Senator Gear Have an Abusive Colloquy.

The Nebraska Offended by the Rude Laughter of Other Senators - The House spends the Entire Day on Private Bills, Chiefly for Pensioners. Washington City, April 17.-The debate on the bond resolution proceeded today.

At 2 o'clock the bond resolution was brought up and Hill resumed his speech in opposition. The galleries were crowded.

Hill declared that with revenues insufficient to meet government expenses bonds were imperative. Certainly the Democratic party should defend the course of the president and the secretary of the treasury in issuing bonds.

When at one point Hill was interrupted by the remark of Allen that the Democratic party was not the party that paid a glowing tribute to his party, declaring that it would live to uphold its principles regardless of the action of the New York legislature.

Allen thereupon called attention to the notorious fact that Collis P. Huntington and his lobby had been here to influence legislation, yet no invitation had been sent to the patrons of the roads.

Allen responded with a glowing eulogy of Gen. Weaver, whose pension Gear broke out in a loud laugh and in the chair of the clockmakers. Allen protested against this "guffaw" declaring that while brought up among cowboys, he was taught water manners that had "Admiral" Gear cannot stand here and utter farcical allusions and go unwhipped.

Hoar interrupted, calling Allen to order and demanding that his words be taken down. This is the parliamentary procedure when objection is taken to the language used.

BULUWAYO IN PERIL.

Matabeles Swarming Like Ants Only Six Miles Away. THE TOWN FEARS AN ATTACK. "Friendly" Natives Undoubtedly Cooperating With the Rebels.

Buluwayo, April 17.-A feeling of apprehension as to what the next step of the revolting Matabeles will be permeated all circles here. Information coming from the country around makes it certain that the natives are preparing an offensive movement against Buluwayo.

On Wednesday evening three Dutch scouts were sent from here to secure some definite and accurate information of the position and movements of the natives. What they have found has served little to allay the anxiety and suspense.

A Matabele "bov" has also been caught stealing loads, and the puggaree belonging to the Rhodesia horse, and it is believed that the situation is serious.
