The keynote of the convention was silver. On that issue all the delegates were based. Neither the temporary nor permanent chairman nor any other referred to anything else in their speeches, and the platform covers only that one issue.

Adopt a Silver Platform and Instruct for Matthews.

Indianapolis, June 24.—The Democratic state convention held in Indianapolis today. The party primaries at the convention preliminaries had been profitable and contentions. The silver question was the only one that was discussed, and the advocates of free coinage had with comparative ease captured a controlling majority. The gold men were promptly defeated. The gold men demanded a call of the counties on the adoption of the majority report. It resulted, Yeas 52, nays 125.

McLean, Thurman, Holden and Finley were declared elected.

Saratoga, N. Y., June 24.—The Democratic state convention that continued the morning and adjourned this afternoon has put itself on record in the financial platform and has selected its delegates to the national convention, but in doing these things it has followed out the predictions of weeks ago and has not created any sensation, or even mild surprise. It has declared its opposition to the gold standard, and has left the selection of a state committee until the next state convention. These things have all been done at the instance of the leaders and with the avowed purpose of placing the party in such a position that, no matter what the platform the national convention should adopt, it would be fully to ignore and impossible to exaggerate the gravity of the conditions under which this convention assembled. Six policemen jumped into the ring, and three officers grabbed Corbett, but Sharkey refused to be restrained, and struck one of the policemen a vicious blow.
