Special Correspondence. REPUBLICAN, Wash., Mar. 2.—Everywhere around the town of Republic and through all the hills and dales that make up the vast area of the camp is heard the sound of quickening industry that betokens forward movement in American industrial life.

Arrivals in the town are so numerous as to become a problem in domestic economy. Several men coming in on late stages recently have had to spend the night without beds. New lodgings houses are going up, but every one of them will be full as soon as it is completed. Heavily freighted sleighs continue to come in day by day, carrying with them all kinds of household furniture and mining equipment.

Open Weather Awakens New Life. With the chink that is blowing today comes the dawn of a new life for the town and for the camp. On every side there are indications that the town is to grow into a city and the camp into a treasure house.

Development Only Begun. It is a long and tedious trip up the steep icy slopes and through the long, dark tunnels, but the visit is well worth the trouble, for it is a revelation as to the mineral wealth and resources of the state of Washington.

rate," says Superintendent Harvey, as he blows out his candle emerging from the mouth of the tunnel; yet the entire northern side of the camp is yet unexplored. Even on the lower level, the level ore has been taken out except that extracted in cross-cutting the vein and in dipping on the west and southward.

I have spoken with the superintendent with which the lead corresponds in the "three tunnels." This applies even where a "fault" is encountered, and the superintendent informs his work accordingly. On one of the levels the men are toiling through one of those annoying bluffs now. "We shall strike the ledge again in ten or fifteen feet," said Mr. Harvey.

Typical Section Underground. The scenes in the depths of one of those tunnels are just such as are familiar to every one who has ever visited a mining camp. A long, low, narrow tunnel, with a main roadway between the rails of the tram, each candle serving only to intensify the surrounding gloom.

Properties of Great Promise. No new claim in the camp is looking better than the Snowdrop group. The shaft is now down thirty-six feet. Samples taken across three and one-half feet of solid ore show assays today of \$12.20 in work on the shaft, which is being sunk at the rate of two feet a day.

SEATTLE AFTER THE TRADE.

Merchants Can Undersell Spokane in Republic Camp. BAUM BILL IS BENEFICIAL. For Nine Months in the Year Navigation on the Okanogan River Is Open as Far as Thompson Creek, the Terminus of the State Road From Kettle Falls, Through the Indian Reservation.

The Post-Intelligencer has repeatedly pointed out the fact that with the expenditure of \$700 on the wagon road from Johnson creek, on the Okanogan river, to Republic, Seattle merchants will be in better condition than ever to control the trade with the mining camps.

Several Seattle houses have representatives in the camp, and from the increased output of the camp, their laborers are not in vain. On the contrary, the outlook is very bright for Seattle to control the trade of the camp, especially on heavy staple groceries and mining machinery, as the local merchants can undersell their Spokane competitors in nearly every line.

A Story in Chapters.
