

TRAVEL FALLS OFF.

Not Many Persons Tried to Reach Nome via Dawson.

George A. Wallace, United States customs officer at White Pass, arrived in the city yesterday from the East. He has been absent a month on a vacation, and will leave for the North today. "The snow at White Pass has been very bad and a good winter," he said. "As soon as a sufficient number of snow sheds have been constructed there will be no more delays on the line."

"During the early months of winter there was considerable talk of a large number of Nome-bound persons would go via Dawson. During the last month this party has fallen off. Fresh snow has been on the road this winter."

Presbyterian Brethren at Odds Over Their Weekly Paper.

MANAGER SMALLEY AND EDITOR WILHELM, OF THE DAYSMAN, RESIGN AFTER ATTACKING CAPT. BALLARD AND F. H. WHITWORTH—TROUBLE STARTS WITH AN ELECTION EDITORIAL—DELINQUENT PRINTER'S BILL UNPAID.

BAD FAITH IS CHARGED.

Manager Smalley and Editor Wilhelm, of the Daysman, resign after attacking Capt. Ballard and F. H. Whitworth—Trouble starts with an Election Editorial—Delinquent Printer's Bill Unpaid.

A scheme of somewhat serious proportions, but of a semi-humorous aspect, has broken out in the First Presbyterian church. The Daysman, a weekly paper, printed under the auspices and devoted to the interest of the church, has been transferred from the management of B. D. Smalley and H. L. Wilhelm to other members of the congregation, including Capt. W. R. Ballard and H. P. Whitworth. The issue of March 17 of the Daysman contains a parting note fired by Manager Smalley and Editor Wilhelm, which contains several spicy allegations against Mr. Whitworth and Capt. Ballard. The current issue of the paper, which is understood to be under the temporary management of Capt. Ballard and Mr. Whitworth, contains a reply to the parting note of the former editor and manager.

The origin of the breach, according to both parties, lies in the position taken by the former editor of the Daysman in the late election in which he discouraged any attempt to involve the church as an organization in the mayoralty campaign. The editor preached the doctrine of non-interference as best calculated to preserve the church from the besmirching influence of practical politics. At a secret meeting of the congregation, as the secretary of the Presbyterian church is called, Editor Wilhelm and Manager Smalley were censured for taking the position they assumed and Capt. Ballard, who was one of the prime movers in the effort to secure the endorsement of Mr. Cotterill, was appointed censor of the paper. Theroupan Manager Smalley and Editor Wilhelm withdrew from all connection with the paper. But not with the church, not omitting, however, to publish an interesting statement in relation to Capt. Ballard and Mr. Whitworth.

The Offending Editorial. Following is an excerpt from the editorial in the Daysman of February 17, to which Capt. Ballard and the session took violent exception: "Municipal politics are now engrossing the attention of the citizens of Seattle as never before. Prior to the nominations many dissatisfaction was voiced among many people regarding the present mayor and his opposition developers. In fact, the many manifested at the caucuses and primaries regarding delegates to the nominating convention. In the most instances the opposition was not in the convention the present mayor was nominated as an almost unanimous choice. After the nomination was made, a conference committee of all the political parties, opposing the party which nominated the present mayor, was organized and all united in a combination ticket to defeat the present party in power.

This is a concrete statement of the prevailing state of affairs. A strenuous effort is being made to array the church upon the side of one of the opposing parties. The editor of the Daysman manifestly, as an organization, is officially, ally itself to any party or semi-party of men. The past history of the Christian and state united, it always resulted in the demoralization and degeneration of the spirit and usefulness of the organization, and at the present time there is no reason to believe that the same result will not follow.

In the present municipal political conflict, the editor of the Daysman believes that the church should fight the warfare of faith and become allied with no body of politicians. If the church discards one set of men as good and another as bad, seeming to discard the members of the church, it would be stultification of the Christian. Judge not that ye be not judged. We did not forget that we (many) look upon the present mayor as a candidate for God's kingdom upon the earth. Yet, if a Christian believes that it is his or her duty to support for the present mayor, it would be stultification of the Christian. But the church, the great living body of our city, should not be dragged into a conflict of the earth and for the earth. The church is not a temporary or worldly affair. It is an organization, built and sustained by the Holy Spirit. It is spiritual. It is holy. Let us work and wait for the triumph of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and not the success of men."

The Editor Condemned. It is not questioned that when the papers in the hands of the members of the congregation on the Sunday following the publication of this editorial, there was a great deal of bitter criticism on the part of Capt. Ballard and other members of the church who had allied themselves in favor of the fusion mayoralty combination. At Capt. Ballard's request, a meeting of the session was held and a resolution passed condemning the editorial and the editor of the Daysman for the same. The resolution was published in the issue of the paper of the 17th of February.

Mr. Wilhelm, whose position in the majority campaign was well defined, being a pronounced advocate of the election of Mr. Cotterill, was appointed censor of the paper, and the publication of matter which did not meet his approval.

Mr. Wilhelm, and Mr. Smalley, the manager, claim that they were not asked to defend their action before the session, whose action came as a great surprise to them. They promptly resigned to retire from further connection with the church.

In an editorial published in the paper of March 17, Mr. Wilhelm and Mr. Smalley announced their retirement at the same time, charging the session with the unpaid printing bills for the publication of the Daysman, which had been guaranteed by Capt. Ballard and Mr. Whitworth. They were compelled to leave the paper.

Manager Smalley claims positively that Capt. Ballard and Mr. Whitworth had personally guaranteed to Printer Moulton, at whose office the Hinkley block the paper had been published, the payment of outstanding bills against the paper, but that they had afterward repudiated this guarantee. In fact, the statement of the manager and editor of the Daysman, published March 17, is as follows:

Fire a Parting Shot. The present management of the Daysman with this issue closes. For seven months prior to the beginning of the present management this paper had not been published because of the arrears amounting to \$100, guaranteed by Capt. W. R. Ballard and Mr. F. H. Whitworth. The bills were not paid. The bill remains to the present time unpaid and the present management is now delinquent upon its personal responsibility, rehabilitating the paper, taking upon himself the obligation of the present expenses, and H. L. Wilhelm, at the earnest solicitation of Dr. H. H. Harrison and Mr. Smalley, was received as printer for the session, both Mr. Smalley and Mr. Wilhelm receiving no remuneration whatever for a period of one month, for their services, which were performed as a Christian duty, with pleasure and for the welfare of the church.

Since the present management have had control in addition to paying all expenses of the paper, the free distribution of the paper, the Daysman has valid into the special church fund \$46 and into the general fund \$10.

Several weeks ago Mr. Whitworth and Capt. Ballard saw fit to object to an article in the paper for which the editor alone had himself responsible. That article was brought before a meeting of the session. Without the editor of the Daysman and without his being given any opportunity of defense, the session passed a vote of

censure condemning the editor of the Daysman and appointing Capt. W. R. Ballard to oversee and censor what items were published other than mere news of church work in the present management would not submit.

The present management have at all times, in all ways, to their utmost, endeavored to publish a paper which would be a credit to the First church and a valuable medium for the spreading of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We have endeavored at all times to hold up the hands of our noble and worthy minister, Dr. A. L. Hutchinson, whose work here in Seattle has been very blessed of God. We have labored earnestly and persistently for a high standard of Christian living, of character and growing interest in church work. We have endeavored to cheer on in every effort to advance the religion of Jesus Christ with an earnest zeal ever uppermost for the speedy and wholesome victory of the risen Lord, the holy Nazarene, the loving Savior.

However, we feel, that under present existing circumstances, our labors are in vain, and we turn over to other hands to be attempted, what our love of the Lord leads us to love to do ourselves. We thank those who have given us words of encouragement—may God bless you!—and the liberal advertisers, who have so willingly given us their patronage, and those who follow us we wish success and only regret that we cannot continue the work ourselves.

Capt. Ballard's Statement. The statements regarding himself in this editorial are disputed by Capt. Ballard. He said yesterday: "When Mr. Whitworth and myself took charge of the Daysman, we guaranteed only to pay the bills we ourselves incurred during our administration. We did not intend to pay the old bills at all."

Mr. Moulton claims that Capt. Ballard and Mr. Whitworth made themselves responsible for the payment of the old account. The Daysman is now being printed at the office of a paper on Western avenue. Under the procedure of the typographical union, to which Mr. Moulton belongs, he can declare the paper unfair until the bill owing him is paid. If he follows this course, as it is understood he may, he can possibly prevent its publication in any union printing office in the city.

THIRTY-DAY SUSPENSION. Penalty Imposed by the Inspectors in the Matter of the North Pacific-Rapid Transit Collision.

Suspension of the Licenses for thirty days each of Pilot Charles B. Oliver and Capt. S. L. West, pilot and master, respectively, of the steamer North Pacific and Rapid Transit, is the decision rendered by United States Marine commissioner Smith today. Neither craft sustained serious injury.

The penalty of suspension was imposed for a violation of the pilot rules and regulations. Inspector Whitney said in explanation of the board's findings.
