Northern Pacific to Cancel Construction Across Line.

MONEY TO BE USED IN THE WEST



Another Cripple Creek record has gone to smash. The value of the March output is estimated at \$2,225,000, as against \$1,444,500 for the same period last year.

The tonnage of all grades for the month amounted to 49,568 tons. The cyanide and chlorina-

tion plants made a big increase in the quantity of ore treated by them. As far as is known the mills in Cripple Creek, Florence and Colorado City, handled 31,268 tons and extracted \$28,825.
