QUESTION IS OF PROXIES.

How the Hart-Godwin Delegation Fight Will Be Settled.

APPORTIONMENT TO COUNTRY.

Democrats Predict That the Delegations From Outside the City Will Be Largely Represented by Proxies—Hart's Friends Claim He is in the Lead in the Country—Godwin and the Single Tax Populists.

In the final settlement of the contest between John W. Godwin and Lee B. Hart for the Democratic nomination for congress, before the Democratic national convention of May 12, it is more than probable that the successful aspirant will be he who gathers in the most proxies from the country. This is the belief of Democratic politicians who are watching the trend of the Hart-Godwin fight.

In the apportionment of delegates to the county convention, the country precincts are allotted 167 delegates out of 344. It is predicted by Democrats who are familiar with conditions in the county that the actual representation in person of delegates from the country will be comparatively small and that in many precincts, if not indeed in the majority, the delegations will be

TRIPP FOR VICE PRESIDENT.

Debate Conner Discusses His Claims for Nomination and Chances for Success.

Herbert S. Conner, Republican national delegate whose home is in Skagit county, is in the city on a business trip. Discussing yesterday the action of the national convention in connection with the candidacy of Bartlett Tripp for the vice presidential nomination at Philadelphia, Mr. Conner said:

"It would be advantageous to the Republican party to honor some Western man with the nomination for vice president. Mr. Tripp's name was presented to the delegation and if he will consent to make the run for the nomination, I believe that the Western delegations will be for him. Mr. Tripp as minister to Austria under President Cleveland developed the characteristics and capabilities of a true statesman. The Chicago platform and the Bryan campaign of 1896 drove him from the Democracy into the ranks of the Republican party. He is an able man, a loyal advocate of President McKinley and a steadfast supporter of sound money."

"Mr. Tripp rendered valuable services to the Republican party in the campaign of 1896 and I hope that it will be possible for the Western delegations to secure favorable consideration for him before the national convention. Mr. Tripp's candidacy for the vice presidential nomination, in any event, will draw attention once more to the claims the Pacific coast and the Northwest generally to consideration at the Republican party of the nation."

DELUDED LONDON BANKERS.

Sensational Answer in Hoshert-Thompson Embezzlement Case.

USED SPURIOUS PHOTOGRAPHS

Defendants Allege That J. G. Torrence Obtained \$125,000 in London to Develop Imaginary Mines in the Klondike by Exhibiting Pictures of Rich Claims Owned by Lippy and Other Klondikers.

The second chapter in the sensational Hoshert-Thompson-Torrence civil and criminal litigation which is now in progress in the superior court was written yesterday when Hoshert and Thompson, who are now awaiting trial on a charge of embezzling between \$20,000 and \$25,000 from Torrence, filed their application for a continuance. The application sets forth that the defendants are unable to safely proceed to trial without the evidence of parties who had knowledge of the business relations existing between the defendants and Torrence, and also alleges a state of affairs which, if proven to exist, indicates one of the most gigantic attempts to defraud foreign capitalists that has come to light since the discovery of the rich Klondike placers.

TO BE COMPLETED BY JULY.

Construction of West Seattle Electric Railway Advancing Steadily—Equipment on the Way Here.

Work on the West Seattle electric railway by the Seattle & San Francisco Railroad & Navigation Company is progressing satisfactorily. The construction is under the direction of S. I. Shuffleton, superintendent of the company. The grade up the West Seattle hill is nearly completed, and the building of the trestle will shortly be commenced. The line will be in operation by July 1.

The line will follow the trestle of the old Seattle Warehouse and Terminal Company across the service to a point 1,000 feet south of the warehouse at West Seattle. There it will go upon the new trestle and take to the main line near the new bridge. The grade is 8 per cent. The Seattle terminus will be on First avenue south, near Pioneer square; the West Seattle terminus at the corner of Cedar street and Grand avenue. It is the intention of the company to construct a loop, which will traverse the principal streets of West Seattle.

Every effort will be made to secure absolute safety on the line. There will be guard rails the entire length of the trestle, and automatic derailing switches on the drawbridge. The overhead construction will be the best obtainable. The equipment will consist of four cars, one of which will be made to secure absolute safety on the line to the other. The equipment is on the way to Seattle, and will arrive here soon.
