THE WORK OF CONGRESS. Congressman Morrow Asks About Samoa.

The House is Asked to Appoint a Special Commission to Investigate the Burlington Strike.

WASHINGTON, March 5.—In the senate today Mr. Morrow reported adversely from the committee on postal and communications the Edmonds and Collins postal telegraph bills, and reported favorably the original bill to regulate the interstate commerce carried on by telegraph.

Among the petitions and memorials presented to the senate were the following: From the Women's Christian Temperance Union for the repeal of the internal revenue taxes on liquors and for a prohibition of the same; the constitution; thirty-two petitions (presented by Mr. Sherman) for the passage of the per diem pension bill and numerous others from other states to the same effect.

The house concurrent resolution directing the secretary of the navy to designate a medium to convey the remains of ex-President Park, of Venezuela, to Lagayra was passed.

Unfinished business (the pension bill) had only one hour for its consideration. The appropriation bill taken up. Among more amendments recommended by the committee on appropriations and adopted by the senate were the following: Reducing the item for erecting officers' quarters at Fort Mifflin, California, from \$200,000 to \$25,000; inserting an item of \$77,000 to complete the repairs of the steam cutter; reducing the contingent expenses of the land office from \$35,000 to \$25,000; striking out an item of \$20,000 for the purchase of land for the United States court, providing for the deficiency for the year 1887; inserting an item of \$30,000 for printing and binding for the postoffice department.

The amendment to strike out the following paragraph: "And the public printer is hereby directed to expedite and print the report of the committee on the department under his charge" having been read, Mr. Hoar inquired of Mr. Hale why those lines should be struck out.

Mr. Hale said there were persons in the department working by the piece who desired to work more than eight hours, who preferred to work ten hours and the adoption of the item might be construed to make those men stop work at the end of eight hours.

Mr. Hoar said that the provision, if it was so construed, was an attempt to forbid a man to work more than eight hours. Therefore, in behalf of the workmen he proposed that the amendment be struck out.

Quite a lively debate ensued between Messrs. Hoar and Hale, the latter withdrawing his amendment. The senate then adjourned.

SPECIAL COMMITTEE ASKED FOR TO EXAMINE THE TREATY WITH CANADA. WASHINGTON, March 5.—Mr. White, of Indiana, introduced the following preamble and resolution today, which were referred to the committee on commerce:

Resolved, That a special committee of five members be appointed by the speaker to proceed to the islands of the Hawaiian group, to investigate the condition of affairs in relation to said islands, and that they be empowered and requested to act as mediators between the Hawaiian government and the United States.
