NATIONAL LEGISLATION.

Internal Revenue Sparring in the House. Discussion of the Copyright Bill Resumed in the Senate - Content One in the House Decided.

WASHINGTON, April 24.-The session of the senate today was opened with prayer by Rev. Dr. H. Parkes Hadden, pastor of the Episcopal church, and a few members of the House were present.

Among the bills reported from committee and placed on the calendar were the following: To provide for the creation of public buildings for postoffice in various cities where postoffice receipts for three years preceding have reached \$5000 annually. The bill is recommended by the postoffice general.

Mr. Hale offered a resolution directing the civil service commission to furnish lists of all persons certified for appointment to the various offices from the 1st of March, 1897, to the 1st of March, 1898, and the lists of all persons selected and appointed under such certification.

The house bill appropriating \$300,000 for an annual at Columbia, Tennessee, was passed.

The senate then resumed its consideration of the international copyright bill, the question being on the amendment offered yesterday by Mr. Merrill providing that newspapers and periodicals should be exempt from the provisions of the bill for the establishment of a bureau of animal industry.

WASHINGTON, April 24.-The committee on elections submitted a report in the case of Frank W. Glover, from the state constitutional convention of Missouri. It finds the contestant, Glover, entitled to the seat.

Calculus bills were reported and placed upon the calendar as follows: For the creation of public buildings at Cheyenne, Wyoming, and increasing the appropriation for the purchase of a site for a public building at San Francisco.

A resolution providing for an investigation of the strike on the Chicago, Rock Island & Quincy railroad was reported back and referred to the committee of the whole.

Mr. Miller, of Texas, asked unanimous consent that all the resolutions might be allowed to print in the Record any remarks on the subject of tariff, but Mr. Reed objected. Then the house went into a session on the tariff bill.

During the course of his speech Mr. McMillan declared that the internal revenue system which the gentleman from Pennsylvania (Kelley) inveighed had not been inaugurated by the Democratic party.

Mr. Kelley admitted that the Democratic party had not enacted the law, but he declared that it had made it necessary for the Republicans to do so.

Mr. McMillan-I stated that \$60,000 were annually received from interest taxes. If the taxes were removed where does the gentleman from Pennsylvania propose to place a tax on tea and coffee? Mr. Kelley-No.

Mr. McMillan-You have not the courage to do it. Mr. Kelley-Here you and your party threaten to tax tea and coffee? Mr. McMillan-We do not propose to take off the internal taxes.

THE KNIGHTS NEED MONEY. THE EXECUTIVE BOARD OF THE KNIGHTS OF LABOR IS IN DIFFICULTY. PHILADELPHIA, April 24.-The need of ready money above the current expense which is now paid with much difficulty, is a source of much concern to the executive board of the Knights of Labor.

At a recent session of the board \$100,000 was appropriated to start a printing office, but aside from the brown shoe headquarters worth \$60,000 the only available property is the Conestoga coal mine in Ohio. The sale of this has been authorized, and the board expect to realize enough to get the printing office well under way, and thereby lessen the expense printing bill which amounted to \$45,000 last year.

The sale of the mine, however, will do little to improve the condition of finances. A member of the board admitted that there is hardly enough money in the treasury to pay current expenses and keep the machinery going until the payment of the July per capita tax.

The quarterly returns are far from satisfactory, and unless money is received between this date and July the force at the general offices will have to be further reduced. The expense of the order are now very heavy. During the year 1895-96 the order gained nearly 60,000 members, and the total expense were \$105,795. Under the present administration, for 1896-97 the order has lost 217,000 members, and the total expense were \$491,668.
