

DOUBLE WEDDING DESPITE DELAYS

Vessel Carrying Fiancees Detained, and Licenses Obtained After Hours.

Y. M. C. A. DIRECTOR AIDS Overcomes Difficulties for Doughboys and Even Furnishes Nuptial Ring.

If a clerk in the Marriage License Bureau had not agreed to stay after hours because the Savole of the French Line was delayed in docking on her last voyage there would have been two disappointed French fiancées, two heartbroken doughboys, a nervous mother and an overworked Y. M. C. A. director to suggest a substitute programme for a double wedding.

The brides-elect had never met before, though they arrived from Europe on the same steamship. And the bridegrooms-elect, both of the A. E. F., did not know of each other's existence until that day. But the quartet celebrated their marriage ceremonies together, after a dash to the Municipal Building to obtain licenses.

The boys were Frank B. Kunselman of Meadville, Pa., Company C, Seventh United States Regular Army Division, and Fred H. Woodard of Birmingham, Ala. Kunselman is one of the former service men awarded a free scholarship under the \$6,000 scholarship fund of the Y. M. C. A. He wrote to Frederick R. Starkey of the Extension Division of the United Y. M. C. A. School that his fiancée would arrive from France on the Savole, and asked how to obtain a license and attend to the other matrimonial formalities.

Mr. Starkey offered to assist, met the Meadville doughboy and accompanied him to the pier, where they waited a long time, the steamship having been held up by a suspected typhus case. While they were waiting the "Y" director noticed another anxious young man on the pier. The two became acquainted with him and discovered that he, too, was a doughboy and was expected to greet a fiancée from France. This man's name was Woodard, and he had come all the way from Alabama. His wedding was to have been solemnized at the Marriage License Bureau, but while talking things over the two bridegrooms decided to have a double wedding.

As soon as the Savole docked Kunselman, Woodard, the two brides-elect, the mother of one and Mr. Starkey jumped into a taxicab and sped to the Municipal Building, where the clerk who had promised to await their arrival and issue marriage licenses after the 4 o'clock closing hour, was on hand.

The licenses obtained, the six drove to the French Presbyterian Church in West 125th street, where the Rev. Paul D. Jeesser was waiting to tie the knot. But either bridegroom had thought of a Mr. Kunselman had left the ring for a bride in his suit case at his hotel and Woodard had intended to buy the ring after the civil ceremony had been performed. Mr. Starkey, never nonplussed, even by such an unusual situation, telephoned to his wife, who drove as quickly as she could from her home to the church and offered her own wedding ring to each couple in turn.

Then followed a wedding dinner and a theatre party, attended by Mr. and Mrs. Starkey and Mrs. Maurice, who accompanied her daughter, Lea Anna Marie, from France to be present at her marriage to Kunselman. As the six happy persons started down the aisle of the theatre the orchestra played "The Marseillaise," which the young French women thought was in honor of their nuptials.

ALBANY, Nov. 20.—The Democratic National Committee reported today to the Secretary of State receipts of \$1,321,455.84 and expenditures of \$1,308,007.12. The statement was signed by Wilbur W. Marsh, treasurer.

The statement showed that \$1,150,843 was turned over to the committee by New York headquarters, \$12,865 by the Chicago office, \$100,000 by the Chicago headquarters and \$4,552 by the San Francisco headquarters.

Gov. Cox and Franklin D. Roosevelt, Democratic Presidential candidates, and Vice-Presidential nominees, each gave \$5,000. Other contributors were: Bernard M. Haruch, New York, \$45,000; Thomas L.
