

JULY TRADE SHOWS REVIVAL IN BRITAIN

Coal Strike's End, Wage Reductions and Lower Bank Rates Are Factors.

COST OF LIVING DECLINES

American Commerce Chamber Issues Report on Improved Conditions.

LONDON, Aug. 6.—Settlement of the coal strike, after more than three months' idleness, the return of cotton operatives to work, and the last minute agreement in the engineering industry have completely transformed the business, industrial and economic aspect of Great Britain, says the American Chamber of Commerce in its official monthly summary of trade.

Wage reductions have now been effected in practically all important industries, including coal, cotton, woolen, road transport, tramways, gas works, engineers and railwaymen. The cost of living meanwhile continues to fall, according to official figures. During June the index figure fell from 128 to 119, a decline of nine points.

The bank rate has been suddenly reduced to 6 per cent. This is believed to be due to action of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, which reduced its discount rate to 5 per cent. The policies of the Bank of England and the Federal Reserve Bank have run on parallel lines for some time.

The British Government will give a grant of \$5,000,000 to foster cotton growing in the British Empire. This will replace the former promise of \$25,000,000 a year for five years. The grant will come out of the profit made in marketing Egyptian cotton during the war.
