

COOPERATION URGED AS FOE TO WASTE

Engineering Council Reports on National Survey Asked by Herbert Hoover.

LABOR'S RESPONSIBILITY

Investigators Find Less Loss in Non-union Plants Because of Lack of Restrictions.

Herbert Hoover's call upon the American Engineering Council to make a national survey of the waste in industry problem has resulted in a report, issued yesterday, by the council's special committee. John H. Williams, a member of the committee, did the bulk of the investigating and he makes the report. He urges cooperative effort as the only effective way to reduce waste. He sees waste that will be most difficult to avoid. In the printing industry, he says, there is tremendous waste, but much of it is unavoidable. In part the report reads: "Labor's responsibility for waste is

notably less in non-union plants because of lack of restrictions enforced by the unions, and the resulting flexibility in maintaining a balance between labor and production. "Without the ability to determine what a worker can or should do, the employer is largely in the hands of his employees, for he is unable fairly to reward his workers according to their effectiveness. Moreover, a worker unable to assure either himself or his employer of the value of his work will vitally lack incentive. "Individual efforts to eliminate waste have proved impotent except for the individual pocketbook. Cooperative effort to eliminate the useless waste of an individualistic industrialism is the need of the hour, and is the theme of this report."


ONE DEAD, 9 ILL FROM TYPHOID IN SYRACUSE
State Helps Local Department Fight Epidemic.

Special Dispatch to THE NEW YORK HERALD, SYRACUSE, AUG. 20.—With one dead and nine additional cases of typhoid developed in the last twenty-four hours, officials in the Department of Health are increasing their efforts to check the spread of the epidemic, which was started by a milkman bringing in raw milk. Mrs. Clinton S. Herrick of 422 Euclid avenue died last night after an illness of a week. Dr. E. S. Godfrey, head of the bureau of communicable diseases of the State

Department of Health, came here to-day for conferences with Health Commissioner H. A. Magruder and Deputy Commissioner Thomas Foreman. District health physicians have been named throughout the infected section, which is one of the most exclusive in the city, and nurses have started checking up all the homes where the milk was delivered.


