REMOVAL TO ST. PETER'S IMPOSING CEREMONY Sacred College Follows Bier From Throne Room.

ROME, Jan. 23 (Associated Press).—The body of Benedict XV. will lie in state in the Basilica of St. Peter's only in day and a half more, according to the present plans. Final decision will be taken on this question Wednesday morning, but it is believed that the Vatican is that it will be impossible to keep the body exposed beyond Wednesday afternoon. The statement was also made to-night, but was not official, that the coffin would be used within a few hours, and that thus the usual ceremony of worshippers filing past kissing the uncovered feet of the dead Pope would be eliminated.

Public Sees Bier. On entering the main door of St. Peter's the funeral party was received by the clergy of the great basilica. They escorted the cortege down the main central aisle to a position in the center of the church just opposite the statue of St. Peter. There absolute took place. The bier was raised aloft and was passed into the chapel of the Holy Sacrament, where the public can view the body through the immense iron gates.

Cardinal Sails To-Day O'Connell Hopes to Reach Rome in Time to Take Part in Conclave.
