

COLLEGE BASEBALL TEAMS ARE GETTING EARLY START THIS SEASON

WALE'S BASEBALL PROSPECTS BRIGHT

Biggest Squad in Years Working Under Three Capable Instructors.

VETERAN PITCHERS BACK

Mack Aldrich, Captain, Sure to Play Third Season at Shortstop Position.

New HAVEN, March 11.—Yale's baseball squad, bigger and more ambitious than ever under the new dynasty of Bernie Tommas, has been ordered out for work in the cage beginning Monday.

Ted Wight, who followed Ross in some of the games for last year's freshman team, has been unable to report because he has been recovering from an operation for appendicitis, but he will don his uniform when reporting time comes on Monday.

The veteran pitchers back are Chittenden, Calhoun and Hartnett. Chittenden did good work for the Southern team a year ago, but was given very little to do during the remainder of the season until a late period. He finally finished the season in a debacle at Cambridgeport, Mass., in which he was close to an otherwise successful season for the 22 team. Calhoun has been out for a year. He pitched several games in 1920, but he hurt his arm in the football season. The injured member has rounded out strong and he will make a good bid for a regular place in the box this year.

Other Boxmen Available. Peterson, Quinn, Norton, Hickey and Crawford are other members of the box squad and each is coming along well. Larry Smith, a freshman last year, is also being tried out. Ross, one of the best of the freshman team a year ago, has dropped back a class and is therefore ineligible.

It is probable that Jim Kernan, last year's first baseman, will be found as regular starter this year. He is easily the best catcher at Yale to-day. Bill Mallory, last year's football star and freshman catcher a year ago, is a good backstop, and Mack Dana will give Kernan a good rub for the place.

Dana is the son of Jesse Dana of the famous battery of Stags and Dana and comes by his catching ability naturally. The slighter build than his father, but in other ways is a ringer for him. For first base the choice seems to be a toss up between Lerner, a senior who played on the freshman team three years ago, and Charlie O'Hearn, a substitute first baseman on last year's team.

The shadow of Charlie O'Hearn as a first baseman looms up always when it comes to reckoning first base men. O'Hearn is a natural player and a good hitter, and he will be a strong contender for the place.

Second Base Candidates. A likely man for the second base is Russell Murphy, who was quarterback in football and second baseman on last year's freshman nine. Others who will try out for the bag on Monday are Arthur Sullivan, catcher, and the varsity squad during the last two seasons, and Dan Kelly, who played a few games at third last year.

Capt. Aldrich, of course, will be found at first base. He is the captain's third year in the position in which he has few if any superiors in the college baseball world.

In the outfield there are several possibilities. Mike Eddy, who played right field last year, will be in his old position, barring accidents, for he is the best outfielder in the college. "Jack" Conlon and at third Eddie Lincoln, both veterans of two years standing. Eddie Goedde, first string pitcher, is starting his third season in the box, and Harlan Russell, who alternated with him last year, is another experienced man. Jerry Murphy, the catcher, has been with the squad two years, serving regularly last spring.

The leaves second base and right field open. Other aspirants for second are Percy Jenkins, who reports to-morrow after a winter with the track team, and Charlie Mason and Gita Rice, who play at center and left field, respectively. For right there are Duncan Thayer, who captained the 1920 freshman team, Joe Clark and Lew Gordon.
