SHOP LEADERS HERE DOUBT CHICAGO PEACE

Cite Pledge Against Separate Agreement Basis.

Pledges have been given the Central Strike Committee here that no separate agreement basis that would in any way weaken position of striking shopmen in the New York district would be adopted at the Chicago meeting to-day of the Policy Committee of the six federated crafts, according to announcement yesterday.

Aggregate of Loans.

The corporation's loans since January 1, 1921, when it resumed operations, have aggregated \$363,536,728. Repayments since that time on account of all loans have amounted to \$158,555,231.

Two-thirds of the loans granted by the corporation were made to financial institutions, but the stronger condition of the banks, particularly in the West and South, has stimulated repayments to the Government, with indications that the banks are more capable of caring for the needs of such borrowers.
