

THUNDERCLAP RUNS POWERFUL RACE IN FEATURE EVENT AT AQUEDUCT

BEATS OPPONENTS IN STIRRING FINISH Carries 133 Pounds and Covers Mile and a Sixteenth in 1:43 3-5.

HIS STABLEMATE SECOND Little Chief Noses Out Flannel Shirt for Place—Another for Belmont.

Harry F. Sinclair's Thunderclap is a powerful horse these days. In the Potomac Handicap at Aqueduct yesterday he picked up 133 pounds, and giving away the proverbial ton of weight to his stable mate, Little Chief, Frigate and Flannel Shirt won in a driving finish by a length, with Little Chief second and Flannel Shirt third.

To win the race Thunderclap ran one of the best races of his great career. He trailed the field until well into the homestretch, then came with a rush and displaying a tremendous burst of speed and bulldog courage got up in time to win cleverly. He traveled the one mile and a sixteenth route in the exceptionally fast time of 1:43 3-5, only three-fifths of a second behind the record made by Mad Hatter last year.

Thunderclap was the best horse in the race and he deserved to win, but Flannel Shirt undoubtedly would have pressed him harder if Johnny Callahan had given him a better ride. Johnny, who is one of the smallest and oldest riders on the turf, is none too brave these days, and when Little Chief and Frigate got close to him soon after the start he eased up and found himself in a pocket from which he was unable to extricate himself until nearing the homestretch. When he straightened out for home Flannel Shirt bounded to the front, but Thunderclap was too close to him and despite a strong finish by Callahan both of the Sinclair horses beat him to the judges.

Oil Man Makes Good. Oil Man, running in the colors of Edward Sims, instead of "Gusher" Bill Rowe, made his first appearance under silks in many months and earned a clever victory. He beat a high class field over the six furlong route in the second race, after leading all the way. Mrs. Payne Whitney's Pirate Gold was second, and Frank Brown's Hephaisitos third. Oil Man stopped over the distance in the real good time of 1:11 4-5.

After many disappointments John E. Madden's Wildrake won a race. In the spring he ran like a fair sort of a colt,

but he went back until yesterday he found himself among a band of platers, and it took every ounce of speed and stamina he possessed to beat them. At the judges' stand he was only a head in front of Rock Salt and a half length ahead of Ambler. Amanda Hoey won the most exciting race of the day, the fifth on the program. She won in a stirring finish by an inch or two. Leghorn was second and Juno third. Amanda Hoey belongs to Ed Arlington. She is a chestnut filly by Golden Maxim out of Eva K. Until Mr. Arlington bought her she used to race under the name of Bernice K. He changed her name to Amanda Hoey, his mother's maiden name. The owner's mother made a special trip to the track yesterday to see the filly run, and Mr. Arlington said later that she nearly died from joy when the filly stuck her nose past the judges in front.

Mr. Belmont's Colors in Front. August Belmont showed another fast juvenile colt in the final race. He is Osprey, by Fair Play out of Olympia. At one time early this spring there was a doubt as to whether or not the renowned Messenger was his superior. That doubt vanished during the Saratoga meeting, but both Louis Feustel and George Odum declared that he was a good colt and would go on and win many races. He took command at the start and led all the way to win easily in the fast time of 58 2-5 seconds for the five furlong course.

Mr. and Mrs. Belmont were at the track to see the colt run.

Goulet and Piani Score in 62 1-2 Mile Cycle Race Alfred Goulet, teamed with Orlando Piani, ran away with the 100 kilometer (sixty-two and a half miles) team race before a crowd of 15,000 enthusiastic fans at the New York Velodrome last night. The race was run on a point basis, with a sprint every two miles for points, thirty-one sprints in all. Goulet and Piani won the race with 122 points. Alex McBeath and Cecil Walker, the crack Australians, finished second with 57 points.

The kid team of Bobby Walthour, Jr., and Charles Jaeger tied with Reggie McNamara and Alf. Gronda for third place, each team scoring 48 points. Fifth place went to Eddie Madden and Willie Hanley, with 33 points. The time of the race was 2 hours 17 minutes 24 4-5 seconds. During the race Goulet won nine sprints. Piani won five.
