

ADRIANOPLE TO BENEFIT BY AMERICAN RELIEF

Methods Effective in Smyrna Will Be Used in Thrace.

ADRIANOPLE, Oct. 14.—Major Morris, in charge of American relief here, said that American methods had proved so effective at Smyrna that the same agencies would be asked to perform similar service in eastern Thrace. G. H. Dennis of Hallowell, Me., has

arrived to report for the Near East Relief, conditions among the refugees from Asia Minor in the Adrianople district, and to prepare for the evacuation that is likely to occur under the Mudania covenant.

'LITTLE HSU' STARTS NEW CHINESE REVOLT

Sets Up Government Independent of Peking.

AMOY, China, Oct. 14 (Associated Press).—Pekin's central Republican

Government, which has been trying to unite all China, has another menacing foe in Gen. Hsu Chuh-chen, known as "Little Hsu," who has captured Foochow and installed himself as leader of an independent government.

Li Hou-chi, Military Governor of Fukien province, escaped to Formosa on a Japanese ship, which he previously had chartered for such an emergency. "Little Hsu" is leading the new Government, and Hsu Tsung-chi is commanding its troops.

In 1920 "Little Hsu" was one of the leaders of the Anfu Club, which was discredited on the ground of pro-Japanese activities. The Anfuites were driven

from power and into exile by northern military leaders.

EX-KAISER GETS JOB FOR NEGRO DRUMMER

Sambo Among First Recipients of Wedding Favors.

POTSDAM, Germany, Oct. 14.—The former Kaiser has begun to bestow wedding favors. One of the overjoyed beneficiaries is Sambo, a negro, who was a favorite of the Emperor in the old days when he was a drummer in the regi-

mental band of the Life Guard Hussars, the pick of the German military machine. It was Sambo who led the band, the practice being for the drum to precede the other instruments.

Since the demobilization of the army Sambo has been out of a job. When the former Emperor heard of him he made inquiries in Berlin. The result was that Sambo will now grace Unter den Linden in a baby blue uniform. The Hotel Adlon has engaged him as a taxi starter. He will be parading in front of the hotel, greeting the arriving Americans and other guests. He is a linguist, and speaks fluent German, even rolling his R's in reverberating German fashion.

STINNES IN PARIS TO ASK FRANCE TO LET UP

Wants Her to Modify Military Control of Germany.

Herr Stinnes is now in Paris seeking to induce the French Government to modify the occupation and military control of Germany. One of Stinnes's directors has been there for several weeks

paving the way for a visit by leading German manufacturers to the destroyed areas and to Paris to hold conferences with French business men. This visit had been planned for the third week in October, but has been postponed.

The visit of prominent Frenchmen, including the De Wendell brothers, to Germany has led German manufacturers to believe that it is possible to reach an agreement with France.
