NEW YORK RECORD IN 5 DAYS ASSURED

Mauretania to Reduce Crossing Time by Touching at Plymouth.

SETS UP NEW RECORD Cherbourg Passage Made in Five Days Seven Hours Thirty-three Minutes.

The corroborating eye witness referred to yesterday was one of two persons close to the scene of the shooting. This man, accompanied by his woman companion, was first noticed in the vicinity of the off-farm house, and later was seen driving into the lane. The authorities learned of this fact when one of the persons told the story of the night's experience to a business friend in Newark. The identity of this friend is known and he has been questioned by the State troopers as to the details of the story told to him.

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McNally ran up four flights of stairs to summon medical help. As he reached the top of the stairs he, too, suffered an attack of heart disease and collapsed. A telephone call brought two ambulances and three physicians from Cumberland Hospital, but before they got there Dr. John Nielsen, fire surgeon, had pronounced Doherty dead. The physicians revived McNally. He was able to go to his home, 271 West 107th street, Brooklyn.
