

**UNEMPLOYED MARCH QUIETLY IN LONDON**

Threatened Attempt to Storm Downing Street Is Peaceful Demonstration.

DESIRE FOR FIGHT LOST

Bonar Law Refers Leaders to Ministries of Labor and Health.

"And against the line of crimson 'Nought can prevail'." That strain from the old Harvard football song feebly tooted by an unemployed band as thousands of bedraggled marchers trudged under the windows of Piccadilly clubs into Hyde Park proved about the reddest feature of this day when London was all prepared for a Red revolution.

Several thousand police mounted and on foot were mobilized in and about Whitehall, prepared to resist the threatened attempt by more than 100,000 unemployed to storm Downing Street and see the Prime Minister. But the innate sense of order of the British workman prevailed over the advice from Moscow, and the men marched peacefully to the Hyde Park fields, where the Government has been comfortably damned every Sunday for generations. Premier Bonar Law did not receive the delegation from the unemployed, but invited the leaders to go to the Ministries of Labor and Health, where they were received by these Ministers, who said their grievances and demands would be laid before the Cabinet as a whole. The leaders say to-night that they are going to stay in London until they do see the Prime Minister. But judging from the temper of the crowd to-day there will be many who ungrudgingly will be cheering the scarlet and gold state with which the King will open Parliament to-morrow. The morning papers were filled with alarm, reciting the criminal records of certain leaders and their connections with Moscow. It had been the plan of the unemployed to assemble on the embankment of the Thames just East of the prescribed limit, demand access, and if refused to filter in by twos and threes and form again inside the limits, but with one foot or mounted policeman for about every ten marchers the long line was docilely herded around outside the police cordon into Hyde Park. By the time they had reached Hyde Park corner all the fight had gone out of them.

There were men and women, people of all sorts and ages from babies in arms to old men on crutches in the line up. Clean cut, tanned ex-soldiers followed long haired, pale extremists. But their weariness, discouragement and shabbiness, despite all the scattered red ribbons, made them all doddle.

**SPENCER DECLARES NEWBERRY INNOCENT**

Although Truman H. Newberry has resigned as Senator from Michigan "Newberryism" broke forth in the Senate again to-day.

Senator Spencer (Mo.) said the \$195,000 spent to elect Mr. Newberry was "spent without his knowledge or consent, since he was out of the State during the campaign, being enlisted in the navy."

Senator Borah took issue with Senator Spencer, saying it was evident from the testimony that an enormous sum was expended with Mr. Newberry's knowledge and consent. He said he thought the Newberry case was closed, but Mr. Spencer's statement reflected on him (Borah) and all other Senators who voted to oust Mr. Newberry.

**WALES TAKES TURN IN LINE**

London, Nov. 22 (Associated Press).—When the Prince of Wales arrived at the House of Lords to-day to take the oath as member of the new Parliament he found a queue of some fifty noble Lords lined up. He took his stand at the end of the line. There was near consternation on the faces of the noble Lords, who offered the Prince their places, but he smilingly declined them all and awaited his turn, which was long in coming.
