FARM BLOC BROKEN, SUBSIDY BLOCKED
 Senate in Legislative Snarl Over Agriculture Upset on Credit.
ROW ON MUSCLE SHOALS
 Ladd Attacks Norris for Opposing Ford's Offer for Development.
JONES CALLED LENIENT
 Commerce Committee Chairman Refuses to Push Advantage on Ship Bill.

 Division of the farm bloc on agricultural credit legislation and failure of the Republican majority to decisively put down delays to action on the ship subsidy bill have led to a legislative snarl in the Senate which apparently has both programs blocked. The farm bloc is split in several directions. Senator Norris insisted today upon action on his farm credit plan. He asserted that if ship subsidy was taken up in preference to this program he would advance the farm bloc measures for direct elections of President and for an earlier meeting of Congress.

Muscle Shoals Row.
 The breach in the farm bloc was widened when discussion opened in the Senate over the Ford Muscle Shoals offer. Senator Ladd (N. D.), in a long speech, scored Senator Norris (Neb.), leader of the farm bloc and insurgent plan for farm relief, for opposing the Ford proposal. Both Senators are prominent in the farm bloc.

 of their apprehension that the necessities of industrial businesses will compel an expansion of the present quotas. "We are entirely satisfied with the present 3 per cent. quota law," an official of the American Federation of Labor said to-day, "because it gives the workman a chance to get a job at a living wage. We fully appreciate the fact that financiers and employers of labor favor unrestricted immigration. But we also know that if there is a surplus of labor due to any expansion of present quotas wages in this country will naturally go down and the interests of organized labor be seriously affected."

Unskilled Labor Problem.
 While admitting there are thousands of persons without employment, Government officials assert most of it is of the skilled sort of a specialized character and that the United States is now almost entirely dependent on immigration for unskilled labor. In discussing this phase of the matter to-day Mr. Husband expressed the opinion that the steps should be immediately taken to devise a method for meeting the demand for unskilled labor.

ALIENS HERE BY ERROR ALLOWED TO REMAIN
