SICK OF GLICK. I came here for the purpose of reporting the demonstrations of the anti-prohibitionists over the pardoning of our governor, and the subsequent release of the recently convicted saloon keepers of this place. I was too thoroughly disgusted, however, to give expression to my thoughts at the disgraceful display by the vulgar herd of the whiskey element gathered together at the release of the ruffians, forming themselves into line in a heavy, drizzling rain, preceded by a band and a wagon loaded with beer kegs and whisky barrels, followed by the pardoned criminals, who were in wagons attended by prominent citizens flaunting the American flag, and marching from the jail through the principal streets howling at the top of their voices."

ENGLAND AND BLAINE.
