Read This and Remember.

There are very few of the many who carry watches who ever think of their delicate mechanism, or of the extraordinary and increasing labor they perform. There are many who think that a watch ought to run and keep good time for years without a particle of oil, who would not think of running a common piece of machinery a day without oiling the wheels, which do but a fraction of the service. For example, the main-wheel makes 4 revolutions in 24 hours, or 1,440 in a year; the second, or center-wheel, 24 revolutions in 24 hours, or 4,320 in a year; the third wheel 192 in 24 hours, or 4,320 in a year; the fourth (which carries the second hand), 1,440 in 24 hours, or 4,320 in a year; the fifth, or scape-wheel, 1,296 in 24 hours, or 4,320,000 in a year; while the beats or vibrations in 24 hours are 432,000, or 157,824,000 in a year.
