FOREIGN NEWS.

London, Oct. 29.—Election returns come in slowly.

Reports from various sources indicate the election of eight members of the party of the center—three conservatives, three national liberals, three German liberals and six socialists. In three other districts the votes are scattering. New ballots will be required.

Paris, Oct. 29.—The result of the parliamentary election in seven districts is now known.

Twenty-nine districts there are no choice. Second ballots will be taken. In thirteen of these twenty-nine districts the socialist candidates will contest with the candidates of other parties. The successful candidates include in thirteen of the center, seven socialists, six German liberals, six national liberals, five imperialists, four conservatives, two people party and French, one Alsatian. Two socialists were elected in Hamburg, one in Saxony and one each in Berlin, Altona and Gross. Eleven more will probably be elected on the second ballot.

London, Oct. 29.—Girdwood and General Brokers, with houses in Bradford and Glasgow have failed.
