A BIG OCCASION.

One Thousand Representative Men of Kansas to be Our Guests.

The Fifth Annual Encampment of the Department of Kansas of the Grand Army of the Republic in Wichita.

The general order of Department Commander Stewart, published this morning, while of a state wide interest, more deeply concerns Wichita, as a city, than it does any other locality. In one month from to-day there will be gathered here from every city and town in Kansas eight hundred or more representative men, who will be with us from two to three days. For the same date the president of the Women's Relief Corps of the state and the colonel of the Kansas Division of the Sons of Veterans have signified their intention of convening the annual meetings of their respective organizations here in Wichita. These will add other hundreds. These representatives constitute, or are, of the respective classes of their respective towns and communities, who will come with their eyes and ears open to visit the busiest town in the state for the first time, and the opportunity should not be lost, but the occasion utilized not only to impress them with our life and business, but with our enterprise and wonderful growth, but with the fact that we are a people socially and intellectually worthy such environments. Notwithstanding the fact that Wichita does more business than any city in Kansas, our location with reference to the older settled portion of the state has been such that no organization of so widely a representative character has ever held an annual meeting at this point heretofore, consequently but few, comparatively, of the leading men of Kansas know what Wichita is really like, or understand the prospects, in truth, that this city has in its splendid young city as is shown by good statistical figures. We hope, therefore, that the weather may not prove propitious, but that our people will not forget the occasion and its importance, and that they will be prepared to put their best foot forward.

As for the members of the G. A. R., which is a very strong organization in this city, we know they will leave no effort untold or unexpended to make the Fifth Annual Encampment not only "a state occasion," but one long to be remembered by the hosts of veterans who will be our guests thirty days hence.
