Big Operators Are Cropping Out of the Market.

PRICES ARE BEING MARKED DOWN

Professionals Again in Control and There is Little Doing in the Street

(By Associated Press.) NEW YORK, Sept. 13.—There were indications in the day's stock market movements of a growing quiescence in the speculation on the part of the large operators whose powerful resources have kept the recent market going through all vicissitudes of money difficulties.

Fluctuations were uncertain and dealings had the appearance of professional operations of the trading class. The upward movement was brisk at the outset in continuation of yesterday's sharp recovery. But it flattened before long and the market lapsed into a duller condition than for many weeks past.

The money market continued to relax and call loans were made throughout the day at below 6 per cent.

The belief in a coming increase in the Anaconda dividend lifted Amalgamated Copper sharply and the Great Northern ore lands deal was a reviving influence on the Hill stocks and on United States Steel. The latter fell back under the enormous weight of the selling to about 47, and the following heavy tone in the market was affected by sympathy with this obstacle.
