WASHINGTON, D. C., March 9.—The administration railroad bill was amended in an important particular by the house committee on interstate and foreign commerce today, when, by a vote of 9 to 7, the committee voted to substitute the interstate commerce commission for the proposed court of commerce as the tribunal designated to receive petitions or applications of railroads desiring to acquire interests in other railroads.
