Senator Mason Wants His Pro-Railroad Resolution Placed on the Calendar.

WAITED IN VAIN FOR REPORT.

Judge of Massachusetts Speaks on Philippine Question—Tribute to the Memory of Mr. Harner.

Washington, March 7.—The Senate seldom accords to any of its members a greater compliment than it accords today to Mr. Lodge of Massachusetts. The announcement that he would deliver a speech on the Philippine question drew to the Senate every Senator now in the city, and to the galleries an unusually large number of auditors.

Mr. Lodge's speech was based upon the bill introduced by Mr. Spooner of Wisconsin, vesting in the President authority to govern the Philippines until Congress should otherwise provide by legislation. He reiterated his well-known position of retention of the islands by the United States.
