

NOT PLEASED BY TAYLOR'S FLIGHT.

Many Kentucky Republicans Resent Action of Their Leader.

HE'S NOW OUT OF THE RACE.

Probably Will Not Be Renominated—Beckham Takes Mount's Action Coolly—John Powers Arrested and Released.

REPUBLICAN SPECIAL.

Louisville, Ky., May 22.—The sudden flight of W. S. Taylor to Indiana has practically ended the plans of the Republicans to make him a candidate at the election next November. It is not at all likely that he will ever return to Kentucky, as he seems to be unwilling to stand trial on the indictment charging him with being an accessory to the murder of William Goebel. Heretofore the Republicans have thought of no other plan than his nomination, but his action in fleeing to Indiana has put them all at sea. It was interviewed upon this subject while he was at Indianapolis, and said:

"It is an awful thing, to be exiled from the place of my birth, from the State that honored me with its highest office and from my wife and children, yet I know, as you know, that my return to Kentucky would be with no chance of ball, for that matter, and exposed to assassins who have awaited an opportunity to wreak vengeance on me."

"I do not know what the future holds. I cannot say that I will or will not be a candidate for Governor of Kentucky at the fall election. The party has indicated that they nominated me, but I fall to see how I could make a canvass, or in the event of election what good could come of it. After a fair election, in which I was declared to be victorious, the Goebel election, the Republican Legislature found a way to overthrow all law and justice and establish Beckham in the executive chair. If this men, it will be repeated in November. What then is the use of my making a race for the office? What is the use of the Kentucky Republicans placing a candidate for Governor and Lieutenant Governor in the field?"

REPUBLICANS DISAPPOINTED.

Republicans are deeply disappointed at Taylor's action, though some say they do not see what else he can do. It is thought that John Marshall, who was elected Lieutenant Governor with Taylor, will be considered the nomination. Marshall is rich and popular, and would have all Taylor's grievances to answer for, but he is sick of politics. Governor Beckham was not surprised when he heard that Taylor had fled to Indiana, but he refused to honor the resignation for the surrender of Charles Finley, Secretary of State under Governor Bradley, but says that he will honor Mount's resignation. Governor Mount's secretary says that Taylor will not be surrendered, as the governor believes he would be lynched if that had happened.

DELEGATES ALL KNOWN.

Kansas Democratic Convention Will Have Little Work.
