

NEXT SATURDAY'S TURF CONGRESS.

Rich Two-Year Stake Will Create Interest Among Trainers and Jockeys.

SIDNEY LUCAS A GRAND HORSE.

Dominick Still Heads List of Winning Jockeys—Burns Has Best Average—Jesse Mathews Riding Well.

There will be two stakes due as usual at the Fair Grounds this week. On Thursday afternoon the Boulevard Stakes, a handicap sweepstakes for 2-year-olds and upwards, at a mile and seventy yards, will be run. On Saturday the introduction of a new stake will create considerable interest in the local turf circles. This stake, known as the Turf Congress Stake, is a handicap sweepstakes for 2-year-olds at six furlongs. This stake will be valued at between \$3,000 and \$4,000, and the trainers of crack youngsters are putting the "babies" through a careful "prep" for the big 2-year-old event. Independent of the money which is being getting inside of the money in this stake, \$500 of the stake will be divided between the trainers and jockeys of the three place horses, as follows: The trainer of the winning horse to receive \$200, the trainer of the second horse \$100, and the trainer of the third horse \$50. The jockey of the winning horse \$50, and the jockey of the second horse \$25, and the jockey of the third horse \$25. This clause will create great rivalry between trainers, jockeys and their many friends.

When the American Derby of 1930, run at Chicago Saturday, and won by Sidney Lucy, is thoughtfully considered, it can be admitted that the winner is a horse of stern quality. Although he was a depressed outcast in the betting, a review of the work of the Derby winner in his career in the year-old forms shows him well fitted for such an event as the American Derby, and that he won it was, probably, no great surprise to his owners, Thompson Bros. On the fourth day of the year-old stakes, Sidney Lucas won the first race on the card at Washington, D. C. Since then he has had a rest of over two months, with one exception, his out in the Canadian Derby. Previous to April 10 of this year, Sidney Lucas, in his 2-year-old form, started twenty-four times. He was in the money sixteen times, and won his second race, in his second year. In his 3-year-old form he made twenty-four starts, and was in the money sixteen times, and won nine wins and seven places and show credits. He has a record of 112 points in the old, which no other youngster in the land can boast of.

On November 15, 1928, he won two races in New Orleans at Washington, D. C. The first race was an all-age event at six and a half furlongs, and he was the favorite, won easily, beating a fair field in 1:22. The next race was a 2-year-old scramble at five furlongs, and he was the favorite, won in a driving finish in 1:32. If ever a three-year-old has been drilled, Sidney Lucas is a case in point. He has been drilled by owners and trainers that a let-up on a good horse once in awhile may reap just what it sows, and Sidney Lucas has shown in when Sidney Lucas galloped away with the American Derby.

Patrons of the Fair Grounds are getting quite familiar with Jockeys John Woods and Tommie Belmont, who were both born in Edinburgh, Scotland. They both inherit the sternness of character generally credited to those of that nationality, and their habits are sober and regular. Little Jimmie first sprang forth prominently in the Kentucky Derby, first meet he ever accepted was for his father, on Maripol. Johnnie has been riding since he was known from County Island to the Cliff House.
