KID McCLOY'S WIFE RELATES SECRETS.

Over Her Own Name She Makes Sensational Charges Against the Fighter.

SAYS HE FAKED REPEATEDLY.

How the Affair With Jim Corbett Feared His Shamming Would Be Discovered.

The sensational charges of duplicity made against James J. Corbett and Kid McCloy probably will be aired in court this week.

Mrs. McCloy's suit for divorce will come up in the Supreme Court, New York, tomorrow, and Mrs. Corbett's parallel case may come up at any time.

Abraham Hummel, on behalf of Mrs. McCloy, will ask to remove that the Court award her a reasonable attorney pending the trial of the suit.

In urging her application Mrs. McCloy will make affidavits concerning the "fake" fights her husband has participated in.

Mrs. McCloy in a signed statement alleges that, with the exception of the Sharkey fight, almost every battle in which her husband has participated during the last two years has involved crooked dealings of some kind.
