

PROPOSED BILLS TO THE SENATE.

Governor Dockery's Plans With Regard to Beer Inspection Law Are Indorsed.

ACTION OF HOUSE IS IN DOUBT.

Legislative Battle Grows Warmer as It Progresses—Where the Opposition Is Coming From.

Jefferson City, Mo., March 14.—By an overwhelming majority the Senate this afternoon passed the two bills providing for a reduction in the beer inspection fees and conferring the power upon the Governor of receiving a sum equal to 10 cents a barrel on all beer manufactured in the State since September 20, 1890. The bills were then referred to the House, where they were read the first time. Tomorrow they will be placed on second reading and referred to a committee. On Saturday the final vote will probably be taken on the two measures.

Intense interest marked the proceedings today. During the morning session in the Senate the chamber was crowded with spectators waiting to see the outcome of the fight for the two bills in the upper chamber.

When Senator Morton called them up for engrossment he briefly explained their purpose. He was followed by Senator Rollins, who opposed the measures.

Senator Farris, who had previously announced himself as opposed to them, said that he now supported them under protest.

Senator Matthews opposed the bill. Senator Drabell said that he would vote for it because he believed it was a business proposition.

Senator Hayes introduced a resolution in the State Treasury within thirty days was better than taking the chances of prosecution.

When the vote on this measure was taken the strength of the opposition was shown. Senators Collins, Cooper and Walker were out of the city. All the Senators voted for the bill excepting only Senator Drabell.

After the first bill was disposed of in such quick order, Senator Morton called up an amendment to the bill providing for a reduction of the beer inspection fees in future.
