St. Louis Cattle Trade Also in Good Condition and Growing Rapidly.

GENERAL BUSINESS NEWS.

The St. Louis live stock market is in an exceedingly satisfactory condition, both in regard to the prices obtained and in the condition of the receipts.

Receipts of horses and mules at St. Louis since January 1 have broken all records, and indications point to heavier receipts in the future.

A comparison of the total receipts at five Western markets shows that in the past fifteen years the total receipts of cattle, sheep and hogs have doubled.

Receipts of sheep and hogs have also been very heavy. Cattle receipts, while not as large as for the corresponding period of last year, have been heavy.
