Congressman Champ Clark of Bowling Green, Mo., arrived in St. Louis yesterday and registered at the Laclede Hotel. A large number of his St. Louis friends and admirers called to see him in the course of the evening, and these he entertained with some of the humorous stories for which he is famous. Mr. Clark is looking well, and to those of his friends who have not seen him since the presidential campaign last autumn he appears a trifle stouter. To the question whether he is to be a candidate for the United States Senate, Mr. Clark made definite reply at length. He not only announced his candidacy, but gave reasons for it, following with an elaboration of his principles: "I would be proud to be a senator."

GIRL PREVENTS ESCAPE OF THIRTY-THREE PRISONERS.

Jailer's Daughter Overhears Plot to Attack Turnkey—The Desperate Men Hold Officers and Citizens at Bay for Three Hours—Five Men Accused of Murder Among Those Who Try to Break Out of the Edwardsville Jail.

FIREMEN SUBDUED UNRULY ONES WITH STREAMS OF WATER.

A daring attempt to deliver thirty-three prisoners from the Madison County jail at Edwardsville, Ill., was made last night by James Johnston, a man under indictment for the murder last summer of James Ryburn, a citizen of Alton. Johnston, in some manner, which his keepers are unable to explain, had secreted the prisoners in the jail yard and had arranged for their escape from the jail. Johnston used the iron rod to pry apart the bars of his cell, going from one cell to another, he released seventeen of his fellow-prisoners, and, with their assistance, was ready to disable Turnkey Thredley and make his escape from the jail. Miss Katherine Hotz happened to pass through the jail yard and overheard the prisoners talking of their plan. Concealing herself until she gained an idea of their intentions, she then hastened to warn her father and Turnkey Thredley. Calling to his aid Sheriff Joseph Hotz, several deputies and other citizens, the jailer tried to drive the prisoners back to their cells. The latter, however, had armed themselves with chairs and other missiles and stubbornly fought their keepers back from the door. Seeing that they could not subdue the desperate men, the officers sent for help. The Edwardsville Fire Department and a hundred armed citizens joined the fight. While the Fire Department played on the prisoners half a dozen streams of water others kept up a hail of missiles. After nearly two and one-half hours of siege the prisoners ceased resistance and cried for mercy. Escorted by armed men, Jailer Hotz and Turnkey Thredley entered the corridor and safely handcuffed the seventeen recalcitrants. The men were then taken to the "bull ring" and strung up by their wrists and hands. Bleeding from wounds suffered in the fierce fight for liberty, almost drowned by the volumes of water, with which they were drenched, and fainting from exhaustion, the men were afterwards marched along the corridor as examples for any of their fellows who might have been in the plot. Last night's attempt at the release of Madison County's prisoners vividly recalls a like feat for liberty made by several desperate criminals a few years ago, and a similar uprising in the Belleville Jail last year. In each of these cases the prisoners killed men to gain their ends. With those tragedies still fresh in their minds, the citizens of Edwardsville last night were loud in their expressions of appreciation of the brave act of Miss Hotz.

KILLED HIMSELF ON A PARK BENCH.

Elderly Unidentified Man Put Bullet in His Brain While Children Played Near By.

An unidentified man committed suicide in Lafayette Park last night by shooting himself in the mouth, while a group of children were playing not more than fifty feet from him. The sharp crack of the revolver came as a discord to the merry laughter of the little ones, and started their mothers, who were occupying the park benches near-by. Sergeant of Police Burns, hearing the shot, investigated, and found the man lying on a bench, with a bullet in his mouth and his eyes staring. The body was taken to the morgue, where a close search of the dead man's clothing failed to reveal anything that would tend to establish his identity. The man was a gray-haired, gray-bearded man. TURKEY'S SULTAN HOLDS A TRUMP.

France Forced to Be Inactive Until After the Visit of Russia's Czar.

Paris, Aug. 30.—The Franco-Turkish situation remains unchanged. It is understood that the French Government will take no active measures to cancel the Sultan until after the Czar's visit to France, in order that nothing may occur to mar the festivities attending that event. Munir Bey, the Turkish Ambassador to France, who is residing in Switzerland, has made a flying trip to Paris, to have an interview with M. Combes, the French Ambassador to Turkey. He came incognito, in order to avoid being handed his passports. What transpired at the interview is not known, but it is believed it will lead to a modification of the situation. The fête planned in honor of the anniversary of the accession of Abdul Hamid II, which was intended to give to the Turkish Embassy tomorrow, has been canceled. The Minister of War, General Andre, withdrew the permission enabling a military orchestra to participate in the celebration. Turkey begins retaliating. Paris, Aug. 30.—The Matin today says the Sultan's first retaliation against France is the publication of an article withdrawing the French religious community at Beyrout, Syria. The French communities at Jerusalem are also taxed.

CLEVELAND APPREHENDED.

Ex-President Questioned by Game Warden—Fisherman Fined.

Pittsfield, Mass., Aug. 30.—Former President Cleveland was one of a party of three apprehended by Deputy Game Commissioners last Wednesday. The Game Commissioners found in the boat in which the distinguished gentleman was seated a bass measuring 7 1/2 inches, while the law requires that they shall be returned to the water if they measure less than 8 inches. The matter was kept quiet until today, when Cassius Scranon of New Marlboro, Mass., was arraigned in court on the charge of having "short fish" in his possession. He pleaded guilty and was fined \$2. The Commissioner at the time of the arrest did not know which of the three men was guilty of violating the law and took the names of all three. "My name is Doctor Bryant of New York," said the first. "My name is Cassius Scranon of New Marlboro," added the second, while the third, a large, stout man followed by saying with a smile, "I'm Grover Cleveland."


VANDERBILT IN POLICE COURT.

YATES'S VICE PRESIDENTIAL BOOM BADLY DISFIGURED.

Whether Vice President Roosevelt Accidentally or Intentionally Side-tracked the Governor's High-Flown Aspirations Is a Question Which Is Agitating Illinois Republicans—Senator Cullom Divided the Honors of the Occasion, to the Chagrin of the Star Attraction and His Henchmen.

IT WAS A RED-LETTER DAY FOR MR. ROOSEVELT ONLY.

Springfield, Ill., Aug. 30.—Vice President Roosevelt's reception here this afternoon was all that could be desired, from a presidential point of view. Whether by accident or subtle design, the Yates vice presidential idea was badly disfigured. Senator Cullom divided the honors of the occasion with the star attraction, and it was Roosevelt himself who moved the lever that side-tracked the Governor's programme. Illinois Republicans are agitated over the affair. The Vice President arrived in Chicago this morning, and at the depot were Colonel Strong of Governor Yates's staff, representing the Governor; Senator Cullom, John C. Cullom, for Illinois, and others. Colonel Strong had arranged for a special train to Springfield, and the Cullom party was at the depot intending to take the regular train. Colonel Strong was anxious to transfer the Vice President to his special car as quickly as possible. For obvious reasons he did not desire his guest to mix with the Cullom crowd. But the Vice President discovered Cullom while greeting Colonel Strong. Vice President warmly greeted the senator. "By George, there's my old friend Cullom," he shouted, and, striding effusively to the venerable senator, he grasped both his hands in a cordial grip. Colonel Strong's face reddened, and after a few minutes he urged his guest to take the train. But Roosevelt discovered Stewart and Ames, and he was in no hurry to leave them. He told Stewart he would see him Saturday. "You have an engagement with the Lincoln Club," suggested Colonel Strong. "How about that, Stewart?" asked the Vice President. "The Hamilton and Marquette are also Republican clubs," replied Stewart, "and they might feel as though they were slighted."
