Springfield, Ky., Jan. 11.—Jim Mays, a negro, charged with assaulting Louisa Jones, the daughter of Joseph Jones, a prominent farmer in this county, six miles from here...

The mob came into town quietly and after approaching Jailer Cattle, demanded the keys to the jail. Their request was refused, however, and they immediately began to hammer the locks on the jail doors.

It took but a few moments to obtain an entrance to the prison, where they found Mays covering in his cell and begging the other prisoners to protect him.

It is not known in what direction the men departed, and it is thought that they will return to the jail.

The negro was arrested and brought here Wednesday. His assault was committed while Miss Jones was returning home from a neighbor's house...
