Again Unanimously Chosen Commander-in-Chief at the Dallas National Reunion.

GENERAL CABELL HONORED.

New Orleans Selected for the Next Meeting Place—Over Six Hundred Missourians in Attendance.

Dallas, Tex., April 23.—The United Confederate Veterans to-night unanimously re-elected General John B. Gordon commander-in-chief, General Stephen D. Lee commander of the Army of Tennessee Department, General W. L. Cabell commander of the Transmississippi District, and elected C. I. Walker commander of the Department of Northern Virginia to succeed the late General Wade Hampton.
