SEALED VERDICT ORDERED IN CASE AGAINST C. H. BUSS.

Indictment Charges Defendant With Raising the Mails Intrusted to His Care.

After waiting until 5:30 o'clock last night for the jury to reach an agreement in the case of the United States against C. H. Buss, who was indicted on seventeen counts charging rifling the mails, Judge Adams, sitting in the United States District Court, instructed the jury to return a sealed verdict, to be opened to-morrow morning.

Buss was formerly a railway postal clerk and is in charge of the postal car on the route between this city and Burlington, N. C. It is alleged that on the night of December 19, 1901, he secured several letters and packages, some of which contained currency, in a wasterpaper bag.


