


FUNERAL OF WILLIAM PAULL IS MARKED BY IMPRESSIVE SERVICES.

At the close of the solemn and impressive burial ritual of the Masonic order, the body of William Paull, secretary of the Castle Square Opera Company, who was killed Thursday by a fall from his window at the Southern Hotel, was lowered to its last resting place in the Castle Square cemetery yesterday afternoon.

The strains of that beautiful song were as a spell upon the hundreds of persons who had gathered to witness the ceremony. At first the hymn was carried by the professional singers, but gradually those who were standing about the grave took up the familiar tune, until the second verse was rendered by an immense throng.
