LONGEVITY OF MINISTERS. Average Age Said to Be Near Seventy Years. Princeton, N. J., Aug. 1.—A report of the Theological Seminary Alumni Association, given out by the Reverend J. H. Dullis, shows the interesting fact that the average minister's life comes close to the three score and ten year mark. The report states that of the forty-one ministers who died during the past year, one had lived 86 years 4 months, two had passed their ninetieth year, five their eightieth, fourteen their seventieth, and six their sixtieth. The youngest died at twenty-nine. The average of the forty-one was 68 years.
