OLYMPIC GAMES

High School Won Greatest Number of Points at Interscholastic Meet.

BIG SATURDAY CROWD AN UNION

Fully 10,000 Persons Visited the New Track and Enjoyed the Races—The Messenger Beaten.

The attendance at Union Park yesterday was fully 10,000. Gatekeepers estimated the crowd as high as 12,000.

Spokane time books were kept very busy during the money wagered on each race. It was said last night that each book handled over \$3,000.

The failure of several heavily played favorites to win allowed the bookmakers to quit winter, something that has been infrequent since the meeting at Union opened six weeks ago.

The failure of The Messenger to win was a conviction that there is a limit to the amount of weight that even as good a horse as The Messenger can give to such a horse as Kenova.

The Messenger was burdened with 122 pounds, while Kenova, a mare capable of going at 1:30 on a fast track, was in with 85 pounds.

The long stay at the post worked to the hardship of The Messenger, with his heavy hip, and once they got off it was Red Light and Kenova for it.

Red Light received a poor ride from Scheon. Lord Hermence lay in nice position at the stretch turn, but there was no available space for McKinney to slip in on the rail and he had to take to the outside.

At that he finished very fast and was only beaten by Kenova by a nose. El Ghor stumbled and fell for a few seconds it looked as though Burton was injured, but the rider was on his feet.

The race for the Messenger was the opening and closing price. Glenzo, at 20 to 1, had no trouble in beating the favorite in the finish. It was strictly a two-horse race.

Belie Mahone, the favorite in the first race, succumbed to Thomaine in the last few jumps.

Honda, the favorite at 6 to 5 scampered in the second race. Furgan was good and had been away well might have won.

St. Noel was made the favorite in the fifth race, but was unable to beat the favorite in the finish. He was thrown out well with the winner to the last seventy yards, when the hand was made.

Setauket, with top weight, 125 pounds, fairly breezed home in the last race. C. B. Campbell was off badly, closed a lot of ground and came fast at the end. Atchey, an odd-on favorite, was much of a disappointment.
