Interest in year-end races always seems to be at a high pitch nowadays, on account of the really high class of the youngsters racing over the old course. Piller looks best in the second event on the strength of his second to Loyal Street on June 25. Harkness started for Charley Ellison a few days ago, but failed to do anything sensational. On the strength of his record, it looks as if he can be placed second, with Preventative in third position.

Lady Ray may win the fifth from a field which is not of extra high class. Echodale has been improving steadily of late, and seems best to put Grant in ahead of him here. In the last race Lord Haven may be selected on the strength of his latest out. He ran wide at the stretch turn, but for which he might have been a factor. AT UNION TRACK.

There will be another contest at Union Park to-day. The track will not be better than heavy and is likely to be sloppy. The fields are somewhat shorter than usual, and there will probably be some scratching.

The third race will be the feature. It is a three-quarter event, but the winner appears to stand out a well-regulated light-horse on a rock-ribbed coast. In this race the Rice entry—Orleans and Gus Lank—look like a sure shot, but a better price will likely prevail.

Lanka is in with only ninety-four pounds and Orleans has but 100 pounds up. Boomerack looks to be the only serious contender, and the handicapper has seen fit to weight him with 123 pounds. The capabilities of this horse are not to be depreciated, but he can scarce win with that sort of a package. Unless the Rice horses run one, two, Boomerack should be second past the wire. In doubt is in with pretty good odds, and has the outside chance, but should be an excellent bet to run third. Tempt and Tom Collins are not heavily penalized, but hardly class with Orleans, Lanka, In Doubt and Boomerack.
