


B'NAI-EL CONGREGATION PLANS NEW \$60,000 TEMPLE

Plans are being prepared for the new Jewish Temple B'nei-El, which will be built at the southeast corner of Spring and Flad avenues. As soon as bids have been submitted work on the construction will begin.

The building will be of romantic architecture with a front of red brick richly ornamented with stone and terra cotta.

The approximate cost of the building when completed will be \$60,000. J. L. West, who is drafting the plans, says that it will be one of the most modern church buildings in the city and that it will likely be ready for occupancy about September 1.

The main building will contain an auditorium which will seat about 700 persons. Galleries for the choir and congregation will also be built in connection with the auditorium.

Across the rear of the lot and connecting with main structure a two-story building will be built containing four large schoolrooms, choir room, a ladies' dining-room with pantry and kitchen, a large assembly hall, directors' room and study.

B'nei-El congregation formerly worshipped at Twelfth street and Chouteau avenue. This temple was sold to the Polish Catholics of that vicinity who renovated the building and are now using it for church services.

CHRISTIAN ENDEAVOR TOPIC. "Whatever He Would Like to Have Me Do."—Matt. vi, 10; John xv, 10-16.

The boy smiled happily. "Indeed, I do, sir," he said.

"And how do you know that you do?" the man went on to ask.

"The answer was a beautiful one. 'Because I always do what he tells me.'"

"Ah, that is the secret of discipleship. We are his friends, if we do whatever he commands us. We are not his friends, but his enemies, no matter how loud our voices are raised in praise of him, if we do not do our own will and go our own way."

It is impossible to be too lowly in this life. The old-time slave became such by allowing his ear to be bored to his master's command. He gladly added to his master's estate, to be done with as his master chose. That is the comparison of a soldier and a man who does not love his God.

It is not the man who has the will to obey, but the man who has the will to obey, and who does not let his will be hindered by the will of the universe. For is not he the doer?

It is not the man who will seek in every way to imitate Christ's will, that this mind may be in you which was also in Christ, and that you may be able to say that you will pray and read the Bible every day. What would you think of the man who would not let his will be hindered to the word of command of a general that did not read the message of his commander-in-chief?

And then, as we obey the first bit of Christ's will that is disclosed to us in that command, we are able to say, "I will do it." And as we obey that, we learn more, and so on endlessly. You have never heard of a man who has obeyed the will of God, and who has not found just what Christ wanted him to do.

All sensible men admit the convincing force of the argument from experience. I make this positive and emphatic assertion: that every man among all the millions of Christians would tell you that all his happiness in life has come from doing the will of Christ, and all his misery from falling to do that will. Is this a testimony that you can afford to neglect?
