New District May Be Bounded on West by Union on North by Bremen Avenues.

Officials of the American Express Company are reporting a new distance tariff sheet which by the free-delivery limit will be considerably extended.

Under the present conditions all commodities shipped to St. Louis by express will be delivered to a district bounded on the west by Walnut avenue, on Olive street and to Vandeventer avenue on other streets on the north by St. Louis avenue and on the south by Shawanah street.

Under the new arrangement the district limit is bounded on the west by Union street, on the north by Bremen avenue, and on the south by Shawanah street.
