New York, March 22.—Suffering from a bullet wound in his right temple, Charles Erd, a prominent young lawyer of St. Louis, with an income of \$10,000 a year, left his hotel at Hotel Imperia this morning, coolly rang the bell for an attendant and dictated a telegram to his law firm in St. Louis, telling the members of his family.

LOUSES SIGHT

It was said at the hospital that he may lose the sight of both eyes, as the bullet had cut the region of the optic nerve. He lost his sight at the hospital, but was inclined to talk in good humor about the affair.

PHYSICIAN'S STORY

At the hospital Erd repeated his statement that he had shot himself accidentally. According to Dr. Gilday, Erd admitted to the physician he had shot himself.
