Legacies Amount to \$679,000 and Residue Estate Goes to Adopted Son.

RELATIVES ARE REMEMBERED.

Washington University Endowed and Professorship Created in College of His Name—Liberal Charitable Bequests.

The will of Charles Parsons, late banker, art collector, author and philanthropist, was filed for probate yesterday.

He endowed Washington University to the extent of \$200,000 for art purposes. The university will also receive at the death of his nephew, Charles Parsons Pettus, his collection of curios, bric-a-brac, bronzes, pottery, porcelain, weapons and carvings, paintings and water colors.
