

LEGISLATIVE CHAPLAINS

The caucuses of members of the General Assembly last evening nominated chaplains for the senate and house, and they will be formally elected by ballot when the two houses organize this forenoon.

It is a curious fact that there is no statute providing either for the appointment or pay of chaplains. Up to 1870, or somewhat later, it was the practice to have prayer offered by a member, or to call one clergyman or another of the city where the General Assembly was in session.

Beginning in 1883, the senate and house each elected a chaplain separately, and the incumbents have been: 1883—Senate, E. P. Parker (Cong); House, G. M. Stone (Bap).

The Congregationalists and Episcopalians divided the chaplaincies between them up to 1880. In that year and the two succeeding years the Methodist and Baptist had them. In 1883, and since then the division has been: Methodists 5, Congregationalists 4, Baptists 3, Episcopalians 2.
