CHARITY AND CORRECTION.

A NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE SOCIETY TO BE HELD HERE.

Arrangements to be perfected by the Local Committee—A Long List of New Haven Members—Delings at the Preparatory Meeting Just Held—Chairmen of Committees Appointed.

The New Haven citizens' committee to arrange for the session of the National conference of Charities and Correction, which is to be held here in May, held a meeting Saturday afternoon at 4 o'clock in the building of the Organized Charities on Orange street. About fifty members were present, including many ladies. The following were appointed chairmen of the different committees:

Reception—General E. E. Bradley. Press—J. B. Carrington. Entertainment—W. H. Moseley. Printing, invitations and badges—Fred A. Betts.

Finance—Joseph Porter. Executive committee—Prof. Francis Wayland; general secretary, Roger S. Baldwin.

The chairman of each committee was given power to appoint four other members of his committee, and given liberty to select persons whose names were not already on the printed list of members.

Mr. Robert Treat Payne, the wealthy Boston philanthropist, the president of the national conference for this year, and also president of the Boston Charity association, was then introduced to the meeting. He said that the congress or conference would be divided into sections. Each section would hold a public morning and evening session and a private sectional meeting in the afternoon. Such topics would be discussed as child work, public and private relief, juvenile offenders, the insane homes for soldiers and sailors, both in the north and south; the care of the sick poor, and organized charities.

Papers would be read by Hon. Seth Low, president of Columbia college, on "Departments of Sociology in American Institutions of Learning"; by Miss Maxwell of New York city, on "Training Schools for Nurses"; and by Prof. J. McCook of Trinity college, on the "Practical Remedies of the Tramp Evil."

These are only a few of the many papers that will be read. The convention will take place in the last part of May; the public sessions in some hall on the college campus. Yale has offered the rooms in the theological building to delegates who do not choose to stay at hotels.

There will be at least 300 delegates representing all parts of the United States, some coming from as far as the states of California and Washington.

This is the national organization's twenty-second annual meeting, and it is fifteen years since it has held its annual meeting in New England.

The reports and papers of the session will be printed and widely distributed among the charitable institutions of the country.
