THAT COMMITTEE MEETING.

What Mr. Morford Should Have Done Under the Circumstances. [From the Tombstone Epitaph.]

The Phoenix Herald does not seem to be very well pleased with an article in last week's Epitaph. The article touched Mr. Morford on the raw. We reiterate that anyone attending that committee meeting was in honor bound to abide by the decisions arrived at, and one of them was that the fighting that was going on in the Republican ranks should stop, and that is one decision that the Herald has failed to abide by.

As to the Herald's charge that the Epitaph is run by a Democratic editor and is controlled by Judge Barnes in the interest of the combination spoken of last week, the statement is false. An effort was made by an agent of Barnes to buy the material of the Epitaph as long as a year ago, and the attempt was renewed at different times up to last May, when the attempt to buy the paper was finally abandoned.

But Judge Berry, Judge Barnes, nor any other Democrat, has one word to say concerning the policy of the Epitaph, and among the Republicans and Democrats of Tombstone it is thoroughly well known that the only persons who have anything to say about the policy of this paper are its present publishers.

Last summer, while the Epitaph was criticizing Governor Wolfley's official actions, the Herald had only words of praise for him. But now, that it is generally understood that the Governor is interested in a rival business enterprise, the Herald sings a very different tune, can see nothing but villainy in every move of the Governor, and because the Epitaph, as a loyal Republican paper, considers itself bound by the decision of the meeting in Phoenix, in the interest of harmony has stopped fighting, will not stand in with the Herald in its present course.
