THE END OF IT.

Bettler and Dunlap's Scrap Settled at Last.

Three Trials Show that Both Gentlemen Disturbed Neither the Peace of Themselves or Others

The tribulations of County Fruit Tree Inspector J. E. Bettler came to an end yesterday afternoon by his acquittal of a charge of a disturbance of the peace at the residence of Mr. P. H. Coyle last Monday.

The evidence in this case was just the same as the modern history dragged into the other two cases. On account of the character of the charge it was not found necessary to make antiquarian researches into the relations between Bettler and Dunlap during a former geological period.

It transpired in the course of the establishment of the fact that the fight between Bettler and Dunlap should be regarded as a disturbance of the peace within the meaning of the statutes that a Mrs. McLain who witnessed it nearly fainted from fright and the intimidating effect of the passage of arms was so great upon the mind of a little girl of Mr. Coyle's that she awoke several times during the next night screaming, "Don't let him kill you! Don't let him kill you!"


