He has been a member of government expeditions and various commissions, and no greater of western life is unfamiliar to him.

He has a most interesting personality, and as a raconteur he is unequalled. He has a charming home life, a wife in sympathy with his work and tastes, and delightful children. He is something of a politician, and any campaign that enlists his sympathies is sure to have more or less grating injected into it, with numerous picturesque situations.

He is a thorough man of the world and one of the few business men of the west who have a broad culture to lighten the roughness of a life largely spent among the conditions of a new country.

He was a soldier in the First regiment of Colorado volunteers. He has a fund of accurate information on the early history of Colorado, and he was in the thick of some of the fiercest Indian wars which occurred in the early 60's. He went to Europe for his art education and spent some years in the best ateliers of the continent, where he still has many warm friends among the well known men of his own profession. ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of the UNITED GROCERY COMPANY.

Know all men by these presents, that we, the undersigned, Simon E. Halligan, a resident of Onida county, state of New York, Edwin E. Kanaley, both residents of Westchester county, state of New York, and Edwin H. Villade, a resident of Hudson county, state of New Jersey, have associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the Territory of Arizona, and do hereby certify:

I. That the name of the corporation shall be the "United Grocery Company," and its principal place of transacting its business shall be at the city of Phoenix, county of Maricopa, Territory of Arizona, with branch offices in the city of New York, the county of New York and the state of New York.

II. That the general nature of the business proposed to be transacted by said corporation is a general mercantile business and manufacturing various food products, with power to purchase and hold lands and sell the same when necessary; to purchase, sell and hold stocks and bonds, both in foreign and domestic corporations, and to purchase all necessary patents for conducting its business.

III. That the amount of capital stock shall be five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) and the number of shares into which it is divided is fifty thousand (50,000) of the par value of ten dollars (\$10.00) per share each. IV. All of said stock shall be fully paid and non-assessable. V. One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) of said stock shall be first preferred and shall be entitled to six per cent (6 per cent) per annum accumulated earnings, to be first paid before the payment of any dividends on any other classes of stock, but shall not participate in any of the earnings of the said company over and above said six per cent (6 per cent) per annum. Said one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) of first preferred stock shall also be preferred, in case of liquidation, as to its principal in full.

per cent) dividends per annum, including said two per cent (2 per cent). All earnings in excess of said eight per cent (8 per cent) shall be paid on the common stock. In case of liquidation, said second preferred stock and the common stock shall share and share alike as to the principal. Said second preferred stock is non-assignable and non-transferable, except that it may by consent of the board of directors be assigned and transferred.

VII. That there shall be one hundred (100) shares of common stock of common stock. Said common stock shall be entitled to all the earnings of said corporation on and after the amount paid on first and second preferred stock as hereinbefore mentioned. Neither the first nor second preferred stock shall be entitled to vote or have any control over the management of said company, at any of its meetings, until there are in arrears for 5 (five) years' dividends on first preferred stock. Then, in case said company is in arrears for five (5) years of accumulative dividends on first preferred stock, said first and second preferred stock shall vote with common stock, share and share alike, in the management of said company.

VIII. The time of the commencement of said corporation shall be on the fifteenth day of February, 1901, and the time of its termination shall be on the fifteenth day of February, 1925.

IX. That the officers of said corporation to conduct its affairs shall be a board of five (5) directors, who shall be elected at the annual meeting of stockholders entitled to vote, on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in each year.

X. That the highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the said company is at any time to subject itself is four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000).

XI. That the private property of each officer and stockholder of said company is to be exempt from all company debts.

XII. These articles of incorporation may be amended at any meeting of the stockholders called for that purpose, by a majority of the stock of said corporation entitled to vote.
