A FIGHT FOR CONTROL Among the Directors of the Maricopa Creamery.

A fight for supremacy among the directors of the Maricopa Creamery company which has been going on for some time took the form of an application for an injunction to prevent the transfer of certain stock. The suit is directed by E. F. Kellner against the Maricopa Creamery company, E. M. Moggett, Emory Kaye, T. J. Elvey and Lloyd B. Christy. The first three defendants are directors of the company, Mr. Christy is only nominally a defendant. The complaint states that at the last annual election of directors, held on May 6th, the following were chosen: E. F. Kellner, William Christy, J. Y. T. Smith, August Hegelman, T. J. Elvey, Emory Kaye and P. M. Moggett. Mr. Smith almost immediately resigned and the vacancy has not yet been filled. The plaintiff is the holder of twenty-six shares of the stock. All the rest was divided among other persons, except nine shares, which were held by the company. On May 16, the complaint says, the newly organized board of directors—that is, the three defendants—agreed to sell these shares at \$25, though the par value is \$50. It is alleged that this sale is a pretense and its real object is to deprive the plaintiff of his share of the stock and thereby a controlling interest in the company. The complaint says that this will be accomplished without interference by the court and it is further stated that on account of the peculiar status of the directors the members can agree upon nothing among themselves, or rather between the two factions. A temporary injunction was ordered to issue. It was stated yesterday, though not in the complaint, that the market value of the creamery stock is above \$20.

STEEL COMPANY CONTROL. How Pennsylvania Railroad's Denial is Viewed.

New York, June 18.—The denial by one of the officials of the Pennsylvania railroad that the company has actually secured control of the Pennsylvania Steel company has convinced Wall Street that the two interests have not made closer connections. Dressel & Co. of Philadelphia are said to have conducted the negotiations for the purchase, and as they are the representatives of J. P. Morgan & Co. of New York it is pointed out that whatever disposition is made of the steel company it is not likely that the object of the road and the steel company is to fight the United States Steel corporation.
