### THE SEWER BONDS MENAGED BY DEFEAT

TOWN HAS TWO DAYS TO GET AWAKE.

Otherwise a Small Minority Will Control Election.

Late yesterday afternoon 180 names had been put on the great register for the sewer bond election, less than one-eighth of the number entitled to registration. There are only two days more for the registration.

While there is no doubt that nine out of every ten property owners in Phoenix are for the bonds, it has developed within the last two days that there is some opposition to them, so that unless the advocates of the bonds hasten themselves today and tomorrow there is danger of their defeat and the thwarting of the will of the great majority of property owners.

The opposition is said to be based on two grounds: It includes men who think that the city should not at this time take on a greater burden than it now has; that the sewer can be dispensed with for a few years more. There are others who admit the urgent need of the sewer, but are opposed to the bond feature, preferring a direct assessment of the property to be benefited.

Unless those who want a sewer regardless of the manner in which it is acquired are aroused out of their apathy, there is danger that there will be no sewer at all.

It was understood a day or two ago that an organized movement was to be made to secure registration for those who are so sure that the bonds will carry that they have not thought it worth while to go to the city hall to register, but nothing has been done yet. It has begun to be suspected that of the 180 who have taken the trouble to register that less than two-thirds will vote for the bonds. No man can vote for them whose name has not been registered by tomorrow night.

### COMPLICATED LAND SUIT CONTINUES

Colonel Frank Woodworth, Who Started the Original South Gila Project, Takes the Stand.

Colonel Frank Woodworth, the original investigator of the South Gila irrigation project, was on the stand all day yesterday in the suit being heard before Receiver Charles E. Arnold at the land office. Colonel Woodworth was examined by ex-Senator Thurston, for the Mayer interests. The cross examination was conducted by Judge Kibbey, in behalf of the Southwestern Fruit and Irrigation company; W. H. Stilwell for J. H. Gant; and R. C. Stanford for the Aztec company.

The hearing began at 9 a. m. and lasted the entire day with an hour off for luncheon. Colonel Woodworth testified to the improvements made by the several companies and the money that has been expended in the development of the project. He said that approximately \$500,000 had been expended. He related the history of the South Gila company and its predecessors and was led through an infinite amount of detail by the attor-

neys. His testimony showed what had been done by the Gila company toward perfecting its claims to the reservoir sites and the canal rights of way.

The suit is brought to adjust the claims of five companies on the South Gila. One of the points that Receiver Arnold will have to determine will be whether the South Gila company's claims for right of way have elapsed.

Whatever the decision of the land office may be it is possible that the aggrieved parties will appeal the case to the commissioner of the general land office. The last court of appeals is the secretary of the interior.

The hearing today will begin at 10 o'clock.
